

# Regulations of Assessment of Certificate for Eligibility to Graduate in the Bachelor's Degree Program of International Business English, Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages

- I. The regulations of Assessment of Certificate for Eligibility to Graduate from Bachelor's Degree Program of International Business English (hereinafter referred to as the regulations) are made to encourage students to acquire professional certificates and enhance competitiveness. The rules are made based on Article XLII of Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages Academic Policies, and the Bachelor's Degree Program of International Business English is referred to as the program in the following articles.
- II. Students of the program should take all the required credits from the course curriculum and acquire at least one professional certificate in order to graduate.
- III. The regulations apply to students enroll in 2015 academic year and onwards.
- IV. Implementations:

(I) The accredited certificates are listed in the chart below:

(II) Students who would like to fulfill the graduation requirement with an off-list professional certificate should apply for approval from the program's affairs committee within two weeks since the beginning of a semester.

(III) Students who fail to obtain any approved professional certificate should take 4-credit international marketing course as a substitute.

- V. The regulations are approved by the program's curriculum committee, college affairs committee and continuing education committee and come into effect after the president's promulgation. Amendments shall undergo the same procedure.
